Sir Arthur Weller CBE

1929 -2011

It is with deep regret that we have to report the death of Sir Arthur Weller CBE, the founder and Chairman of Citadel, who passed away after a short illness on 30 November 2011 aged 82.

Without Sir Arthur's inspiration, acumen and dedication Citadel would not exist. Throughout a 50-year career in insurance, his intuition and expertise created a group of companies that continue to respond to changing times. He remained active in Citadel's direction and expansion until his end. He will be greatly missed.

Sir Arthur's funeral took place at 10.00 am on 7 December 2011 in Sydney, Australia, a fitting place to commemorate his charitable work that included the building of *Young Endeavour*, Britain's official presentation of a sail training schooner to celebrate Australia's Bicentenary in 1988, and his deep involvement in the construction of a replica of Captain Cook's *Endeavour*. Both vessels remain as testimony to his energy and gift of opportunity to others.
